A special City Council meeting was held March 24, 2021 at the City Hall Chambers at 6:30 pm. Present were Mayor John Larsen, who called the meeting to order, Public Works director Ryan Billheimer and council persons, Kyle Irlmeier, Rick Hays, Perry Leeper and Rick Stanley and Jeremy Gettler and Clerk Randi Lehman.

Motion by Irlmeier and second by Leeper to approve the agenda. All ayes.

Public Hearing: Proposed FY22 City Budget

Motion by Irlmeier to open the Public Hearing. Second by Gettler. All ayes.

Attorney Fichter presented the budget to the council. Budget contains funding for the community center, possible splash pad and Audubon Street. It maintains the current level of operations.

Motion to close the Public Hearing was made by Gettler and second by Stanley.

Discussion and possible action on Resolution 21-0324-01: Resolution to approve the FY22 City Budget

Motion by Hays to approve the FY22 city budget as presented. Second by Gettler. All ayes.

Discussion and possible action on Public Works Equipment purchase.

Billheimer presented cost and financing for a tarpot and router and air compressor. The tar pot and router are approximately \$58,838. The air compressor is approximately \$11,500. The City spent \$25,000 for seal cracking in 2020.


Motion by Gettler to approve the purchase of tarpot, router and air compressor for a total of approximately \$75,000. Second by Irlmeier. All ayes.

Public Comment


Ashley Smith presented the council with her plans on the building she purchased at 314 Audubon Street and discussed the grants that she has applied for and what the City's part is in the grant application.
